

From Handicraft to Cultural Heritage: Redefining the Role of Traditional Handicraft in Shanxi's Cultural Expression

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Abstract

This study examines the development of traditional handicrafts in Shanxi from crafts utilitarian to cultural heritage and redefines their role of Shanxi cultural expression. Traditional handicrafts in Shanxi played an immeasurable importance in understanding and explaining the underlying cultural origins. However, traditional handicrafts nowadays have been seriously impacted by the globalization and modernization, especially in the development of productive forces. In recent years, many inheritors of traditional crafts are abandoning the craft due to low productivity and low income, and these conditions are leading to the decline of traditional handicrafts.

Most of the handicrafts incorporate rich human history, regional culture, and ethnic customs, reflecting the production life and social activities of the people of Shanxi, and the history and culture of Shanxi. In different regions of Shanxi Province, there are a variety of traditional handicrafts, each with its own characteristics. For example, the art of colorful sculpture in Datong area attracts countless people with its vivid, splendid, and colorful features. Embroidery is an important traditional handicraft in the Changzhi region of Shanxi Province, which is a technique of utilizing needles and threads for pattern decoration on cloth woven fabrics. Beautiful patterns bloom vividly on the fabrics under the skillful design of the artist's hands. It's extremely high level of skill and unique artistic charm make it not only loved by local people, but also an important gift for friends and relatives, and a beautiful accessory for home decoration. The art of paper-cutting in Yuncheng area, with its unique lines and shapes, has sent people's good wishes. In addition, mud sculpture in Linfen area, porcelain in Jincheng area and bamboo weaving art in Jinzhong area are all unique handicrafts in various areas of Shanxi Province. In general, the traditional handicrafts in Shanxi Province show a deep cultural connotation and artistic spirit with their unique craft techniques and traditional design concepts. In today's rapid development of modern society, these intangible cultural heritages should be effectively protected and inherited, so that more people can realize and appreciate their beauty.

Shanxi Province is renowned for its deep historical roots and rich cultural diversity. Traditional handicrafts, central to the region's cultural heritage, face significant challenges from globalization and modernization, such as market contraction and the loss of cultural value. Consequently, the research titled "From Craftsmanship to Cultural Heritage: Redefining the Role of Traditional Handicrafts in Shanxi's Cultural Expression" is particularly vital. This study not only focuses on how to effectively protect, develop, and pass on these cultural assets to adapt to new cultural contexts and market demands, thereby achieving sustainable cultural development, but also aims to create more effective strategies through the evaluation of existing protective measures by policymakers and cultural institutions. Therefore, this study is not only a significant academic exploration in the field of cultural heritage but also a crucial contribution to the strategy for sustainable cultural development in Shanxi and beyond. The study focuses on the following objectives: (1) to recognize and understand the value of traditional handicrafts from the perspective of cultural heritage, (2) to mobilize public attention and participation in traditional crafts, and (3) to formulate effective strategies and policies for the protection and development of traditional handicrafts. The results will provide a new theoretical basis and practical guidance for the protection and development of traditional handicrafts in Shanxi and throughout the country.

Background of Study

Material and Method

The study is to use bibliometric analysis to analyze the field of traditional handicraft and its development in Shanxi region. Bibliometric analysis is a set of methods used to quantitatively analyze scientific and scholarly literature. It employs statistical and mathematical techniques to examine publications, such as articles, books, and patents, to understand the structure, patterns, and dynamics of scientific research. Bibliometric analysis or scientometrics is a technique that consists of the application of mathematical and statistical methods to carry out a quantitative study of bibliographic units Donthu et al (2021); Kumar et al (2021), making it possible to understand the path and evolution of a certain subject area. In essence, bibliometric analysis is a powerful tool for understanding the landscape of scientific research, guiding strategic decisions, and enhancing the overall efficiency and impact of scholarly communication. The Scopus database was used for the selection of documents due to its coverage a greater information. The decision of using Scopus database in based on the largest volume of information regarding authors, countries and institutions provided (Zhang & Eichmann-Kalwara, 2019; Cicea et al., 2021). In addition, it contains the largest volume of articles and journals that meet the scientific quality requirements for peer review (Baas et al., 2020). Through keyword and content analysis can help the authors identifies the frequency and trends of specific terms and phrases within the literature to understand emerging research themes and directions.

Results and Discussion

To reach the objective of this study, there are 150 papers Scopus have been reviewed. The keywords for obtain the information based on several words such as traditional handicraft, handicraft innovation, culture heritage, process and production of traditional handicraft, handicraft prevention and modern product design. The search of information specifically focuses on China and Shanxi province.

Redefinition of the Role of Traditional Handicrafts in Shanxi's Cultural Expression

At the same time, Shanxi has also strengthened the social power of cultural heritage protection by conducting various exhibitions and seminars to provide the public with a deeper understanding and awareness of handicrafts. However, there are also many challenges. First, despite Shanxi's efforts to protect and pass on handicrafts through various means, individual handicrafts are in danger of disappearing due to a shortage of talents and difficulties in passing them on. Secondly, in the process of industrialization of handicrafts, it is necessary to avoid reducing the cultural water of handicrafts, and to avoid the decline in quality caused by over-commercialization. Furthermore, along with the rapid development of modern society, the younger generation's interest in traditional handicrafts is gradually decreasing, which undoubtedly brings great challenges to the inheritance and development of traditional handicrafts. In addition, the development of modern science and technology has made the production cost of handicrafts higher and higher, and it faces greater difficulties to go into people's daily life. In addition, the protection of traditional cultural heritage, especially intangible cultural heritage, has yet to be improved in terms of the improvement of the legal system and its enforcement. The rights and interests of some folk artists are not effectively safeguarded, which can have a negative impact on the protection and transmission of cultural heritage.

In the face of today's challenges, multi-faceted solutions are needed to ensure that the unique and rich handicrafts of Shanxi Province continue to develop and be passed on to future generations. The first and foremost recommendation is for government departments to adopt positive means to protect and support the crafts community, including the creation of a favorable environment and conditions for crafts through policy support and financial investment. For example, some economic subsidy policies should be implemented to provide financial assistance to enterprises and individuals engaged in the production of traditional handicrafts, to alleviate their operating pressure. At the same time, the Government should also provide training and guidance in technology and marketing to help craftsmen improve their professional skills and strengthen their competitiveness in the market. The second solution is to set up a special fund for those handicrafts that are threatened with disappearance due to a shortage of talents or inheritance problems. The fund can provide support and encourage willing heirs to learn and master these precious skills. In addition, we should also make more students understand and meet traditional culture through the education system and school education, and study and research on handicrafts. This will not only cultivate their appreciation and creative talents, but also prepare them for the next generation of handicrafts. Finally, the public should be mobilized to participate in the protection of intangible cultural heritage by organizing various forms of exhibitions and experiential activities to give the public more chances to contact and understand handicrafts, to enhance their understanding of handicrafts and improve their cultural confidence and

cultural pride. Satisfying the above requires not only the joint efforts of the government, education, communities, and craftsmen, but also the support and cooperation of the whole society. Only in this way can we truly protect and promote the development of our handicrafts, so that they can flourish in the hands of outstanding heirs and continue the charm of centuries-old good manufacturing.

Conclusion

In the process of in-depth study of Shanxi's traditional handicrafts and cultural heritage, it was found that they are not only valuable in terms of history and art, but also have real economic value in the modern economy. Craftsmen have largely sustained the sustainable development of local communities, created employment, promoted the export of handmade products, attracted tourism, and maintained the uniqueness of local character and identity. At the same time, it is also recognized that traditional handicrafts are not only crafts, but also lifestyles, people's understanding, and expression of life. Therefore, promoting the revival of traditional handicrafts in Shanxi Province not only helps to preserve and pass on valuable cultural heritage, but also has far-reaching implications for the social resilience and economic health of local communities. On a broader level, the development of traditional handicrafts also represents the valuing and recognition of human creativity and innovation and is an expression of human cultural diversity and ecological diversity.

The future of traditional handicrafts and the cultural heritage of Shanxi Province is yet to be further researched and explored, and we should devote all our efforts to the preservation and development of these heritages to realize the sustainable use of these valuable resources, not just to win economic benefits. This is an important social responsibility and our commitment to future generations. We expect that future studies will provide us with more information and insights, more strategies, and directions for creating an inclusive, innovative, and sustainable social environment.

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
